

Nappy Changing Procedure:

Date: September 2018

Review Date: October 2019

- Ensure bathroom door is kept open at all times throughout this procedure.
- Put clean gloves and apron on.
- Ensure all necessary equipment is available.
- Practitioner to interact and support the child's independence throughout the procedure (appropriate to age and stage of development)
- Practitioner to use this opportunity to extend on children's language.
- Support the child onto the changing unit.
- Remove the nappy, place into the nappy sack and dispose of into the nappy bin.
- Clean the child using wipes/ cotton wool, disposing of this immediately.
- Apply cream when necessary (according to medicine form and complete details/time etc).
- Put clean nappy on and encourage children's independence where possible when dressing the child.
- Clean changing mat with Anti-Bacterial spray and paper towels (remove spray immediately).
- Dispose of paper towels, apron and gloves in a nappy sack, tie and place into the bin.
- Wash hands thoroughly using hand wash provided.
- Ensure the nappy chart is completed immediately after procedure.
